- AllHealth has deployed a state-of-the-art Health Equity training curriculum developed by national leaders. This training is being deployed to the entire AllHealth Network staff and Board Members
- AllHealth is intentional about building diverse teams as well as partnering the diverse suppliers; this is where innovation is born.

- AllHealth has integrated tools to address health inequities. We are partnering with Gray Matter Analytics and implementing a solution which incorporates SDoH and will enable our organization to quickly access dynamic value-based care (VBC) insights to identify members or patients at risk, achieve significant performance gains, and improve health and well-being outcomes.
- AllHealth has implemented a post-service tracking and monitoring team that follows-up and monitors clients; especially client's who have received acute care services.


