### 2021 Colorado Health IT Roadmap Progress

- State Agency Data Sharing Agreement developed, approved by GDAB
- · Identity Cross-Resolution Roadmap, backlog of systems to onboard
- Provider Directory "front door" project underway
- Consent standardized form in English and Spanish, backlog established
- Recommendations from Local Public Health Agencies to establish data strategy for system improvements
- Chatbot to promote access to women's health care in Colorado



2021 COLORADO HEALTH IT ROADMAP PROGRESS



- ~\$4 million under contract to support connectivity for telehealth
- Community Resource Inventory mapping and recommendations complete
- · Telehealth Payment Parity and Denials analysis
- · Awarded 13 libraries for telehealth/tele-hub kits
- Awarded contract for Social Health Information Exchange to progress toward a single connection point/scalable data sharing platform.
- OeHI/CDLE/CBO awarded ~\$900k to create a State Digital Equity Plan

# 2021 Colorado Health IT Roadmap Planning Retrospective

- → Community engagement activities included:
  - More than 50 stakeholder meetings
  - Virtual regional learning collaborative telemedicine meetings
  - Community meetings in Haxtun and Trinidad
  - ◆ Two virtual public listening sessions
  - An online survey
  - The Annual Innovation Summit with Prime Health in September 2021
- → Steering committee of 6 eHealth Commissioners
- → Contract with CHI for ~4 months
  - Project Management
  - Data Collection/stakeholder engagement
  - Data synthesis and roadmap planning
  - Publication-ready roadmap
- → Emphasis on people first and more digestible content

  - Policy
  - Projects
  - Best practices, recommendations for industry
