# Interoperability Program & JAI Overview



JAI is a partnership between CDHS, HCPF, CDEC, OIT and multiple Federal partners with the vision of aiming to serve the full range of needs that an individual, family or community may need by better connecting business processes with technology and data. *Standardization of Business Process Management and Document Management are critical steps* in achieving Interoperability across systems to serve clients more efficiently and effectively.

# Interoperability Program & JAI Overview, cont.



In the last year, we procured an objective, third party to complete <u>Auxiliary System Study</u> work for ACSES, CBMS, CHATS and Trails:

- Slalom identified 26 core capabilities,
- inventoried 9 different solutions and, and
- outlined 16 impact assessment findings.

Slalom introduced a recommendation to channel existing experience, knowledge, insights, and strengths into a <u>common statewide platform with shared DNA</u>.

ILC vote in summer 2022 → move forward with working together (State and Counties) to implement a singular, unified system.





### Completed:

- Project Kick-off on 10/5 (100+ county folks in attendance)
- State-County Blended Team Procurement
  - Lead County Business Strategist
  - 2 additional part-time County Analysts
  - 3 additional State resources
- Finalize Roadmapping
- Kick-off for full county engagement on 2/15
- Completed a full sprint for Child Support and Child Care Assistance

\*Completion of Solution Identification phase in November of 2023 and full Implementation in June 2025\*

# Current Status & Upcoming Opportunities



### Currently:

Completing a sprint for Child Welfare

### Other Currently:

- ullet Document Digitization Assessment o assess amount of paper volume in counties statewide
  - Completed 14 onsite visits to representative counties
  - Focusing on gathering data from the remaining counties
- Document Digitization Scanning
- Unified Analytics & Reporting → workforce metrics, performance, trends, policy decisions, etc.

\*Targeting all active cases are paperless (or have a solution to be) by June of 2024 & Fully Paperless Statewide by 2027\*


# High-level Next Steps for Auxiliary System



- Stop investing in siloed approaches
- Solution Identification -- in progress
  - Expansion of Capabilities Discovery (including Business Process) -- conducting
     3rd of 6 sprints
  - Technical and Data Solutioning -- initiated with OIT
- Procurement -- targeting completion in early 2024
- Implementation -- targeting completion in June 2025
