Exit 1
25%

- State Agency Data Sharing Agreement developed, approved by GDAB
- Identity Cross-Resolution Roadmap, backlog of systems to onboard
- Provider Directory "front door" project underway
- Consent standardized form in English and Spanish, backlog established
- Recommendations from Local Public Health Agencies to establish data strategy for system improvements
- Chatbot to promote access to women's health care in Colorado

Exit 2
50%

- ~\$4 million under contract to support connectivity for telehealth
- Community Resource Inventory mapping and recommendations complete
- Telehealth Payment Parity and Denials analysis
- Awarded 13 libraries for telehealth/tele-hub kits
- Awarded contract for Social Health Information Exchange to progress toward a single connection point/scalable data sharing platform.
- DeHI/COLE/CBO awarded ~\$900k to create a State Digital Equity Plan

Exit 3
75%

- Colorado Health Innovation Resource Platform Phase 1 complete
- Demographic data baseline for safety net facilities in progress
- Collaborator with In Full Health initiative
- 98% of Critical Access Hospitals and Rural Health Facilities connected to HIE networks
- Rural Community Analytics Platform in development
- Technology upgrades for behavioral health and home and community-based services providers: \$26M grant opportunity underway
