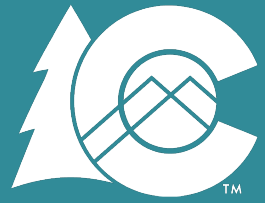
- **Alignment** - All current OeHI project investments align with one or more of the Updated Health IT Roadmap initiatives.
- **Opportunities** - Some Roadmap initiatives are incomplete or are not being addressed by current OeHI project investments.
- **Next Steps**
 - Gap Analysis
 - Prioritization
 - Defining Success



- **Gap Analysis**
 - Determine what other work (public or private) is already underway that OeHI and the eHealth Commission can leverage and engage.
 - Identify gaps to address within Roadmap initiatives and feasibility within the next three years.
 - Assess whether current OeHI-funded activities are fully addressing the priorities and what additional work or changes are needed in the next three years.
- **Next steps**
 - OeHI and Commission chairs to focus and prioritize the scope of the gap analysis to be completed in the next 2-3 months, using Roadmap values and the Commission's prioritization matrix.



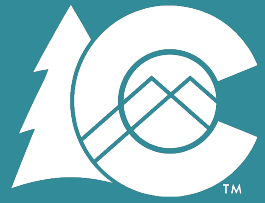
- ***Aligning Policy, Funding, and Services Decisions***
 - Align, integrate, and coordinate the policy, funding, and technology investments for the state's health agencies
 - Establish and jointly lead a technical architecture review committee for all state-funded health IT projects
- ***Community Engagement***
 - Support efforts for direct collaboration and coordination across state agencies and with community partners
- ***Governance***
 - Build upon and expand the Statewide Health Information Governance Committee to address Roadmap goals
- ***Operationalizing Policy, Funding, and Services Decisions***
 - Offer venues for investing in innovative solutions and promote policy solutions at the state level
 - Advise state agencies on their implementation efforts with strategic support from the Commission
 - Embed staff within departments as needed to provide additional capacity and support
- ***Monitoring for Accountability***
 - Monitor project and contract management to keep the big picture goals in mind while meeting deadlines
 - Coordinate partners, provide financial support for the work, and ensure end users are getting what they need



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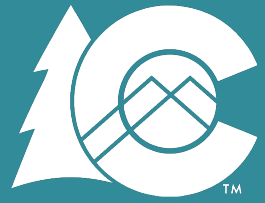
