The Office of eHealth Innovation (OeHI) is responsible for defining, maintaining, and evolving Colorado's Health Information Technology (Health IT) strategy to support administration priorities. OeHI and the eHealth Commission coordinate and advise state agency, community, and statewide efforts related to this work. Colorado's Health IT Roadmap is the "north star" strategy developed with stakeholders statewide, steered by the eHealth Commission a Governor appointed advisory committee, and continuously evolved to meet community and state needs.

Common Health IT Infrastructure

Ensuring health information is easily accessible & usable within & across community services to provide effective coordination of care.



Governance & Policy

Aligning Colorado's policies, regulations, & investments to promote the secure sharing of health information.



Digital Health Innovation

Continuing to lead & adopt innovative technical approaches in support of Colorado's health priorities to increase equitable access and save people money on health care.
