



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



- **What are the goals/outputs?**
 - Increase HIE connectivity amongst Rural hospitals and clinics
 - Funding Strategy for new approved funding
 - HIE connectivity
 - System upgrades for Rural Providers
 - Technical Assistance

- How our efforts link to the Refreshed Roadmap Objectives
 - Equitable access to information - By increasing HIE connectivity for rural providers, we will increase access to health data for rural patients
 - Access to health services through technology - By increasing access to broadband and telehealth in rural communities
 - Improves health equity through connectivity - By improving digital accessibility for rural Coloradans we help those in rural communities that have higher percentages of publicly insured patients

- How is health equity incorporated into the workgroup?
 - Rural Communities have higher burdens of poverty and poorer health outcomes. By increasing access to health IT for Rural Providers we can improve care delivery for high need communities.

- **Previous workgroup accomplishments**
 - Rural Analytics project underway
 - Colorado Rural Health Center has been contracted to provide technical assistance for HIE connectivity and analytics


- What has been accomplished?
 - All contracts for Rural Analytics for FY22 are executed and OeHI has almost completed execution of all FY23 contracts.
 - CCMCN has submitted an implementation plan for a minimum viable product solution for analytics with a Fall 2022 release
 - The HIE connectivity strategy to connect remaining CAHs/RHCs has been finalized
 - Additional Rural Connectivity Funding had been approved



Building from the Past



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


Strengthen community connections to develop meaningful insights in support of equitable access to quality care and services for all Coloradans.


- Increasing **alignment** across state agencies, clinical and community-based members of the care team

OeHI's Implementation Timeline




