




REVISIONS MADE TO FIRST DRAFT



- Separated the Master Data Management (MDM) requirements into 4 groups:
 - 1. Master Person Index (MPI)
 - 2. Master Provider Directory (MPD)
 - 3. Integrated MPI/MPD
 - 4. Infrastructure support
- Defined the initial priority use cases
- Provided additional background on the process being undertaken to help ensure success during RFP solicitation
- Incorporated specific revisions and additions to business and functional requirements
- Added additional data elements suggested through first public comment period



MPI/MPD Qualifed Bidder Requirements

Comparison with the Office of eHealth Innovation Charter

Process

Per request of the eHealth Commission. The Office of eHealth Innovation reviewed the draft MPI/MPD qualified bidder requirements with the office charter.



Office of eHealth Innovation Charter

Serve as a central point to coordinate and distribute funding for Colorado's Health IT priorities.

Establish criteria for qualified organizations who can administer Health IT projects;

Hold selected qualified organizations accountable for their solutions and vendors who are implementing Health IT projects; and

Ensure selected qualified organizations have longterm sustainability plans for the operations of Health IT projects

eHealth Commission will have visibility into these processes as they develop

2 Public Comment Period

The Public comment period for the draft MPI/MPD Qualified Bidders Requirements closed on February 01. Compiled comments will be shared next eHealth Commission meeting.
