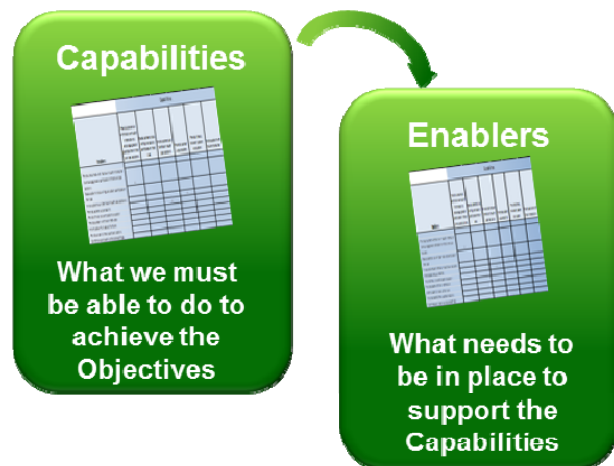

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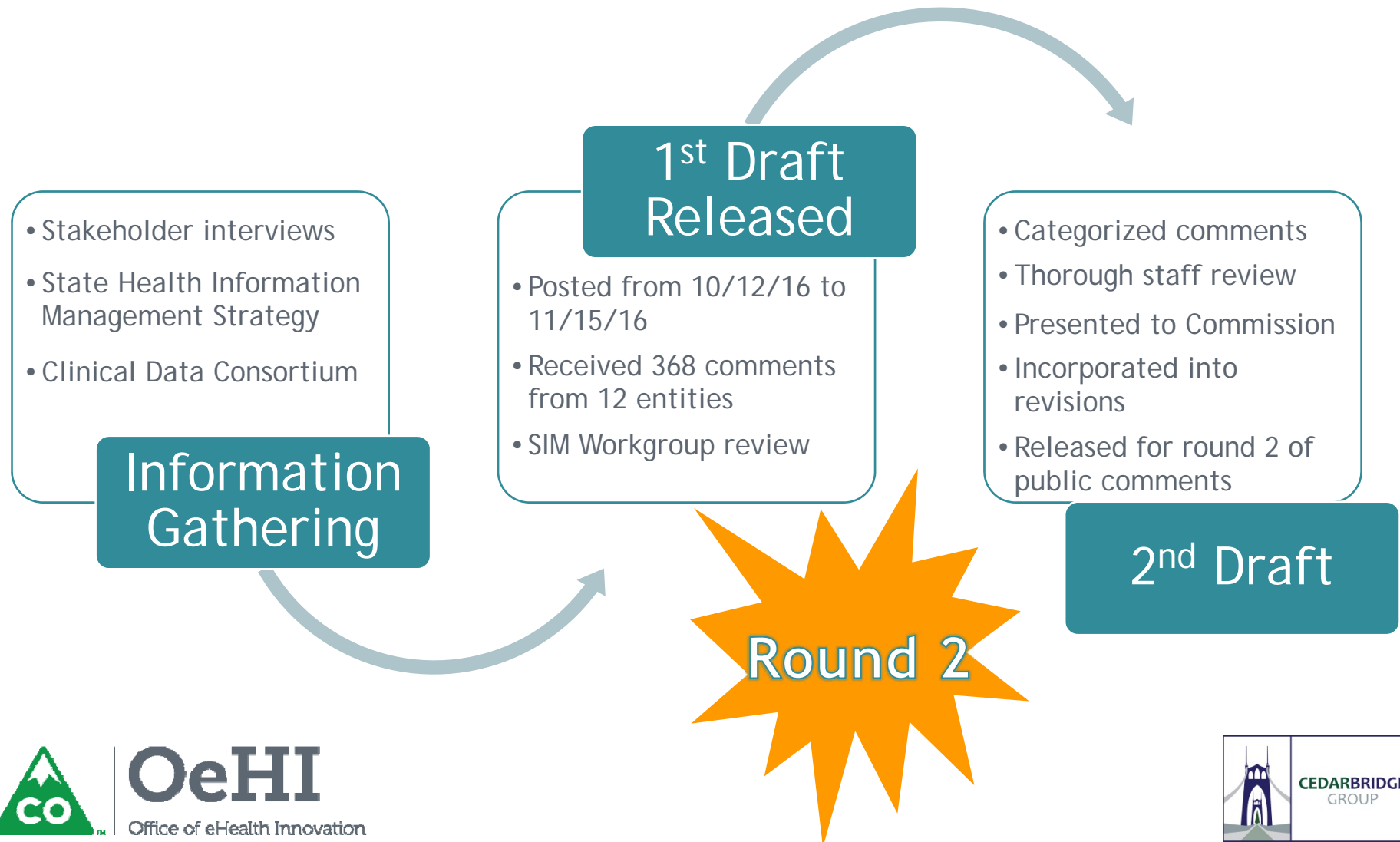

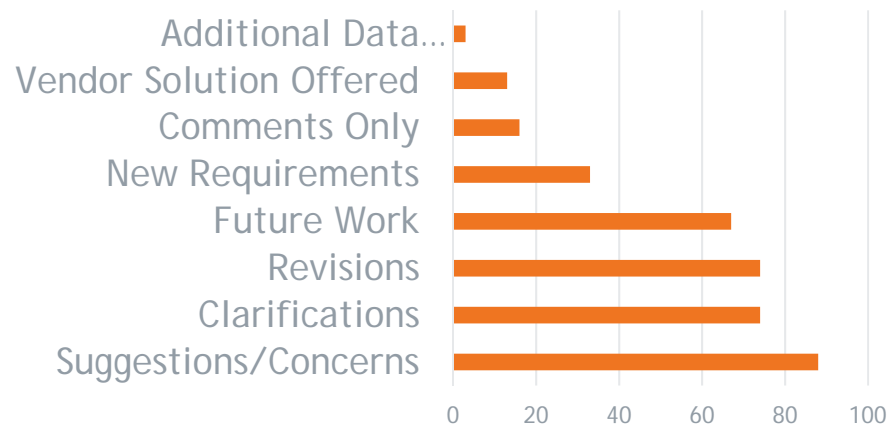


REVISIONS MADE TO FIRST DRAFT

- Separated the Master Data Management (MDM) requirements into 4 groups:
 1. Master Person Index (MPI)
 2. Master Provider Directory (MPD)
 3. Integrated MPI/MPD
 4. Infrastructure support
- Defined the initial priority use cases
- Provided additional background on the process being undertaken to help ensure success during RFP solicitation
- Incorporated specific revisions and additions to business and functional requirements
- Added additional data elements suggested through first public comment period

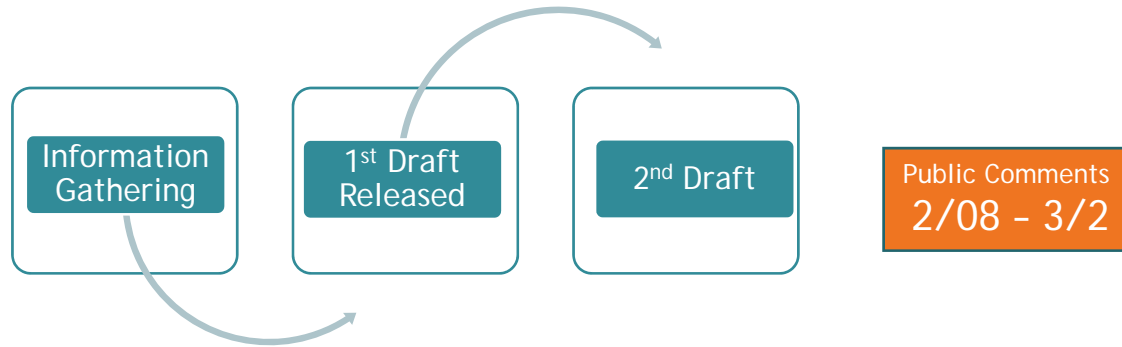

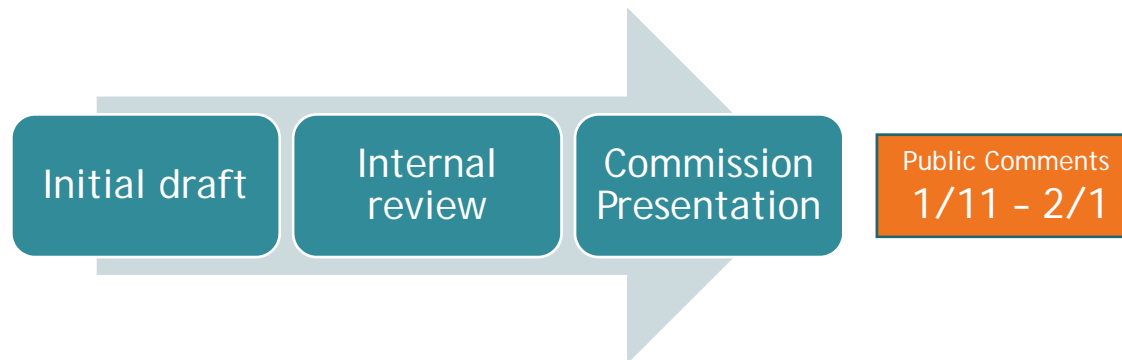

Process

Per request of the eHealth Commission, The Office of eHealth Innovation reviewed the draft MPI/MPD qualified bidder requirements with the office charter.



1 Office of eHealth Innovation Charter

Serve as a central point to coordinate and distribute funding for Colorado's Health IT priorities.

Establish criteria for qualified organizations who can administer Health IT projects;

Hold selected qualified organizations accountable for their solutions and vendors who are implementing Health IT projects; and

Ensure selected qualified organizations have long-term sustainability plans for the operations of Health IT projects

**eHealth Commission will have visibility
into these processes as they develop**
