- (National Analysis) National Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology (ONC), ONC Data Brief No. 60, Electronic Public Health Reporting & Recording of Social & Behavioral Determinants of Health Among Office-Based Physicians, 2019 (Aug 2022)- From the ONC overview, "Using data from a nationally representative sample of physicians, this brief describes primary care and other office-based physicians' electronic public health reporting and social and behavioral determinants of health data recording capabilities and how they varied by physician and practice characteristics. This analysis offers insights into physicians' readiness to electronically support public health activities in the year prior to the pandemic; it does not report on physicians' overall levels of public health reporting—which can occur through manual, paper-based methods—nor does it reflect recent levels of electronic public health reporting which may have improved during the pandemic."
